

2010 Cal Learn Program Data:

Since 1994, Cal Learn has touched the lives of 175,881 teens (aged 12-19) and their children.

In 2010, Cal Learn served 19,053 female teens and their children throughout the State. This means that 38,106 or more children (teen mothers and babies) are impacted and at risk of poor outcomes if supportive programs are eliminated.
